SPECIAL CONDITIONS – EXEMPTION

Permit number CPM 40251

The Exemption is not transferable and it expires when ownership of the land changes, or if there are any changes to the fenced/enclosed area, or when the permit-holder resigns;

Only a person authorized thereto by the MEC may make an alteration on the exemption permit;

1. The exemption shall be subject to the provisions of any law in force during the period of validity of the exemption in the area to which the exemption applies;
2. The exemption shall be subject to the implementation of the **approved management plan**;
3. The exemption shall be valid only in respect of the fenced area defined in the application for this exemption on the land of the owner whose name appears on the exemption;
4. This permit authorizes the holder thereof to hunt, catch, or sell those species appearing on this permit, or convey to or from the listed exempted farm to another exempted farm the species that occur on both exemption permits. Such exemption holder may further **grant written permission to any other person** to carry out the above activities [except the selling by public auction, and conveyance only by a registered wildlife translocator] with regard the species of wild animals listed on the exemption.
5. A written permission must be given to each person **prior** to a hunt, capture, sale or conveyance of a listed wild animal; this written permission must be carried by such person whilst carrying out the activity allowed. The written permission also authorizes a hunter to convey the carcass to his or her property;
6. No person may without a permit, on land upon which wild animals are found or likely to be found and which is fenced in such a manner that such wild animals cannot readily escape, make an opening in the fence so designed that wild animals entering the land through the opening, cannot easily find the opening to escape.
7. The Exemption permit **does not allow the hunting** of any wild animal on such property with a **prohibited hunting method** except if specifically specified. Prohibited hunting methods are prescribed in terms of Section 38 of the Limpopo Environmental Management Act.
8. An exemption for bow hunting does not authorize the holder thereof to hunt **hippopotamus, buffalo and birds** with a bow and arrow;
9. For the bow hunting of medium size animals, including mountain reedbuck, impala, blesbuck, warthog, bush pig, springbuck and nyala, a compound bow, compound crossbow, or a longbow, generating a minimum kinetic energy of not less than 50ft/lbs. and arrow weight of not less than 380grains may be used;
10. For the bow hunting of large size animals, including wildebeest, kudu, gemsbuck, zebra, waterbuck, sable and hartebeest, a compound bow, compound crossbow, or a longbow, generating a minimum kinetic energy of not less than 60ft/lbs. and arrow weight of not less than 415grains may be used;
11. The arrows must have a minimum length of 50 cm long and must have at least two cutting edges. An additional kinetic energy of 5% must be added when using mechanical broad heads.
12. The arrows must have a minimum length of 50 cm long and must be equipped with a sharpened flat steel broad head with a minimum width of 2,8 cm without barbs;




SPECIAL CONDITIONS – EXEMPTION

13. The holder of this exemption permit must apply in writing for renewal of the permit within two months prior to the expiry date at their local Environmental Affairs Office;
14. This permit does not authorize the keeping of live wild animals in captivity such as small breeding camps; a special captive breeding permit is required.
15. If the following game species occur together on the same property, they may only be hunted and may not leave the property alive, the species are the following: Blesbuck & Bontebok, Blesbuck & Tsessebe, Tsessebe & Bontebok, Burchell's zebra and Hartmann zebra, Blue wildebeest and Black wildebeest;
16. Mass capture and conveyance of these animals may only take place from 1 March to 30 September in the same year.


GENERAL INFORMATION / ALGEMENE INLIGTING

1. This exemption may be cancelled, withdrawn or amended at any time by the MEC;
2. The holder of this exemption who contravenes or fail to comply with any of the conditions or requirements to which the exemption is subject, shall be guilty of an offence (Section 115);
3. The holder of an exemption shall, at the request of any person authorized in terms of LEMA so to demand, forthwith produce such exemption to such person (Section 96);
